### **Qualifications:**

- Current on your lease through Feb 2020
- Cannot pay rent and/or utilities due to economic harm from COVID-19
- Must be 18 years of age or older and a documented tenant at current address

#### **Required Documentation:**

- Completed Lease Agreement
- Utility bill in your name for residence
- Proof of income affected by COVID
- Proof of Household income/pay stubs
- Proof of rent delinquency (eviction notice or rental ledger from landlord)
- Proof of delinquent utility accounts (past due bill/ cutoff notice)

## Landlord Required Documentation:

- EIN/SSN/W-9
- Tenants Rental Ledger & Lease Agreement

#### **Next Steps:**

- Contact Gaston County Health & Human Services Adminitstrator Angela Sanford @704-862-7963 or Liaison Henry Armfield @704-862-6776 to sign up and become an approved participating landlord
- Inform qualifying tenants with delinquent rent that they may apply for assistance immediately
